Membership Criteria



New Steering Committee annual members would **need to contribute since February 2022, or have committed to contribute**, at least **0.1% of the country's 2022 GDP and** at least **USD 1 billion** in order to be considered for membership. This includes direct **budget support, support to reconstruction and recovery projects**, and other forms of financial assistance, but not military or humanitarian assistance, or financial contributions that have military purposes.

This new member would be temporary, participating in the Steering Committee as long as its **assistance at this significant level continues to be disbursed**, and therefore the need for coordination remains. For countries which are Member States of the European Union, only their bilateral assistance would be taken into account.

In order to **ensure Ukraine's economic recovery continues on its pro-market, democratic reform trajectory**, Platform members must be established democracies with market economies.

Annual Observers:

Applicant countries **should have contributed since February 2022, or have committed to contribute**, substantially (at least **0.05% of the country's 2022 GDP or** at least **USD 300 million**) to financial and economic support to Ukraine. This includes direct **budget support, support to reconstruction and recovery projects, and other forms of financial assistance**, but not military or humanitarian assistance, or financial contributions that have military purposes.

For countries which are Member States of the European Union, they should have **provided or committed to provide bilateral economic assistance** of at least **0.05% of the country's 2022 GDP or** at least **USD 200 million** to Ukraine in addition to their contributions to the EU budget.

In order to **ensure Ukraine's economic recovery continues on its pro-market, democratic reform trajectory**, Platform observers must be established democracies with market economies.

The participation as observer would be for **one year, renewable if the level of support remains** equal or greater than the previous year.

Annual observers of the MDCP **could observe all Steering Committee meetings from an online observer room**, their experts could observe all online expert meetings, and the observers would receive all Steering Committee materials and read-outs.

Annual observers **would be able to participate in an annual expanded session** of the Steering Committee on the margins of the Ukraine Recovery Conference.

How to apply?

Countries that **wish to apply for member or observer status**, following the membership expansion criteria outlined in the above, are **invited to share with the Platform's Secretariat a summary of the country's contributions** to Ukraine's economic development. The Secretariat will provide a template to use for this purpose.
